WHEREAS, Dennis Esaki, born on November 20, 1951 in Kaua'i, is a helicopter pilot, civil air patrol pilot and Harley Davidson motorcyclist; and

WHEREAS, Dennis Esaki attended Anahola School, graduated from Kapa'a High School in 1969 and later from the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa in 1972 with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Geology; and

WHEREAS, Dennis Esaki, during his career with R.M. Towill Corporation from 1974-1979, worked in Hawai'i, Guam, Palau and the Marshall Islands; and

WHEREAS, Dennis Esaki founded Esaki Surveying & Mapping, a private company located in Lihue, in 1979, and incorporated his business in 1982 which has now become Kaua'i's top surveying and mapping company; and

WHEREAS, Dennis Esaki has served as President for the Esaki Surveying & Mapping, Inc. for the past 33 years and under his leadership, Esaki Surveying & Mapping has continuously striven to provide the best support required for engineering design utilizing modern surveying equipment and expertise from working with various government agencies; and

WHEREAS, Dennis Esaki was named the U.S. Small Business Administration's 2003 Small Business Person of the Year for Kaua'i, and has received numerous awards from the Contractors Association of Kaua'i; and

WHEREAS, Dennis Esaki has a long-standing history as a community leader in Kaua'i;


