Diane Frances Ohana Foundation**

**WHEREAS**, according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, breast cancer is the second leading cause of cancer deaths among women (approximately 111 woman die from complications of breast cancer every day); and that the State of Hawai'i's breast cancer deaths have remained near or below the "Healthy People 2010" objective since 1993 and well below U.S. rates; and

**WHEREAS**, Diane Frances Kempski Logan was a single mother, daughter, sister, aunt, friend, nurse and Army Veteran who died from complications of metastatic breast cancer on Thursday, August 23, 2012; and

**WHEREAS**, the Diane Frances Ohana Foundation was established in Diane's name to give support to women with Stage IV metastatic breast cancer and their families; and is dedicated to doing all it can to help those fighting bravely against this dreaded disease;

**WHEREAS**, Diane Frances Kempski Logan is remembered every Thursday by family members, friends and acquaintances alike by wearing something purple which has become known as "Happy Purple Thursday;" and

**WHEREAS**, the Diane Frances Ohana Foundation is honoring her memory at a celebration in Honolulu, Hawai'i on August 23, 2013; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, NEIL ABERCROMBIE, Governor, and I, SHAN S. TSUTSUI, Lieutenant Governor** for the State of Hawai'i, do hereby proclaim August 23, 2013, as

**"DIANE FRANCES KEMPSKI LOGAN DAY"**

in Hawai'i and ask the people of the Aloha State to join us in celebrating the life Diane Frances Kempski Logan.
