In Recognition of the 10th Anniversary of Dress for Success® in Honolulu

WHEREAS, Dress for Success® Honolulu began in 2002 with a mission to promote economic independence for disadvantaged women by providing professional attire, a network of support and the career development tools to help women thrive in the work place and in life; and

WHEREAS, Dress for Success® Honolulu provides women with tools and resources that will help them achieve success, including:

- Resume Writing;
- Interview Coaching;
- Career Counseling;
- Power Networking;
- Job Retention Skills;
- Career Advancement; and

WHEREAS, Dress for Success® Honolulu has more than doubled the number of women it serves from 199 in 2010 to 549 in 2012; and, in its 10 years of existence has served more than 3,500 women on O'ahu; and

WHEREAS, Dress for Success® Honolulu is celebrating the grand opening of its new home at YWCA Laniakea in Downtown Honolulu; the space is six times larger than the previous location and will provide new employment programs for economically disadvantaged woman;
