



NOW, THEREFORE, I, NEIL ABERCROMBIE, Governor of the State of Hawaii, by virtue of the authority vested in me under Section 171-11 and Section 183-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, do hereby order that the following described land, identified as "Withdrawal Portion of Koolau Forest Reserve, Governor's Proclamation dated August 24, 1905 and June 12, 1907 as modified by Governor's Proclamation dated May 2, 1938," situate at Honomanu, Hana, Maui, Hawaii, containing an area of 0.60 acre, more or less, more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and delineated on Exhibit "B," both of which are attached hereto and made parts hereof, said exhibits being respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, being designated as C.S.F. No. 25,047 and dated January 27, 2011, is hereby withdrawn from the operation of Governor's Proclamation dated August 24, 1905 and June 12, 1907 as modified by Governor's Proclamation dated May 2, 1938.



Honomanu, Hana, Maui, Hawaii

Being a portion of the Government (Crown) Land of Honomanu.

Beginning at the bottom of the south bank of Puohokamoa Stream at the southeast corner of this parcel of land and on the west side of Hana Highway, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "PUU KUKAI" being 10,021.52 feet South and 8707.39 feet East, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

Along the bottom of the south bank of Puohokamoa Stream along the remainder of Koolau Forest Reserve, Governor's Proclamation dated August 24, 1905 and June 12, 1907 as modified by Governor's Proclamation dated May 2, 1938 for the next five (5) courses, the direct azimuths and distances between points along said bottom of the south bank of Puohokamoa Stream being:


