

State Parks, being those parcels identified as:

"Addition to Kealakekua Bay State Historical Park, Subzones A and B," situated in off-shore waters at South Kona, Island of Hawaii, Hawaii, Subzone A containing an area of 120.0 acres, more or less, and Subzone B containing an area of 195.0 acres, more or less, more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and delineated on Exhibit "B," both of which are attached hereto and made parts hereof, said exhibits being respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, both being designated C.S.F. No. 25,236 and dated November 21, 2012, and

"Napoopoo Pier Site," situate at South Kona, Island of Hawaii, Hawaii, being all of Land Court Application 1011, filed in the Office of the Assistant Registrar of the Land Court of the State of Hawaii, containing an area of 0.77 acre, covered by Owner's Certificate of Title No. 14,071 issued to the State of Hawaii, subject to any encumbrances that may be noted on Owners Certificate of Title 14,071, more particularly described in Exhibit "C" which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, said exhibit being a survey description prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, being designated C.S.F. No. 22,397 and dated January 22, 1996.

SUBJECT, HOWEVER, to the condition that upon cancellation of this executive order or in the event of non-use or abandonment of the premises or any portion thereof for a continuous period of one (1) year, or for any reason whatsoever, the State of Hawaii, Department of Land and Natural Resources, Division of State Parks shall, within a reasonable time, restore the premises to a condition satisfactory and acceptable to the Department of Land and Natural Resources, State of Hawaii.

SUBJECT, FURTHER, to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this Executive Order.

This executive order does not authorize the recipient of the set aside to sell or exchange or otherwise relinquish the State of Hawaii's title to the subject public land.




