

Pedestrian Easement P-1, more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and delineated on Exhibit "B," both of which are attached hereto and made parts hereof, said exhibits being respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, both being designated C.S.F. No. 25,310 and dated September 5, 2013.


SUBJECT, HOWEVER, that the County of Maui, Department of Water Supply, shall maintain at its sole expense the walkway along the mauka boundary of the subject parcel that provides public access to the adjacent County of Maui's Kelaweia Mauka III Park.

SUBJECT, FURTHER, to the condition that upon cancellation of this executive order or in the event of non-use or abandonment of the premises or any portion thereof for a continuous period of one (1) year, or for any reason whatsoever, the County of Maui shall, within a reasonable time, restore the premises to a condition satisfactory and acceptable to the Department of Land and Natural Resources, State of Hawaii.

SUBJECT, FURTHER, to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this Executive Order.

This executive order does not authorize the recipient of the set aside to sell or exchange or otherwise relinquish the State of Hawaii's title to the subject public land.



WATER SUPPLY MAINTENANCE BASEYARD

Paunau, Lahaina, Maui, Hawaii

Being a portion of Royal Patent 4475, Land Commission Award 7713, Apana 26 to V. Kamamalu conveyed to the Territory of Hawaii by Pioneer Mill, Limited by deed dated June 25, 1907 and recorded in Liber 292, Page 408.

Being, also, the Former Lahaina Water Works Reservoir Lot.

Beginning at the north corner of this parcel of land at the east corner of Lot 27 of Kelawea Mauka II Subdivision, File Plan 1287 and on the southwest side of Kanakea Place, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "LAINA" being 4519.07 feet South and 75.18 feet East, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 323° 45' 212.84 feet along the southwest side of Kanakea Place and along Lot 26 of Kelawea Mauka II Subdivision, File Plan 1287;
2. 54° 25' 30" 252.78 feet along Lot 46-C, Part B of Kelawea Mauka III Subdivision, Phase II, File Plan 1746;
3. 154° 27' 80.80 feet along Lot 84 of the Kelawea Mauka Subdivision, File Plan 1150;
4. 181° 45' 165.56 feet along Lots 84 and 85 of Kelawea Mauka Subdivision, File Plan 1150;



5. 233° 45' 135.83 feet along Lot 92 of Kelawea Mauka Subdivision, File Plan 1150 and along Lots 28 and 27 of Kelawea Mauka II Subdivision, File Plan 1287 to the point of beginning and containing an AREA OF 1.015 ACRES.

SUBJECT, HOWEVER, to Pedestrian Easement P-1 as shown on plan attached hereto and made a part hereof and more particularly described as follows:

Pedestrian Easement P-1:

Beginning at the east corner of this easement, being also the end of Course 1 of the above-described Water Supply Maintenance Baseyard, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 54° 25' 30" 9.00 feet along Lot 46-C, Part B of Kelawea Mauka III Subdivision, Phase II, File Plan 1746;
2. 143° 45' 144.00 feet;
3. 233° 45' 9.00 feet;



4. 323° 45' 144.11 feet along the southwest side of Kanakea Place and Lot 26 of Kelaweia Mauka II Subdivision, File Plan 1287 to the point of beginning and containing an AREA OF 1297 SQUARE FEET.




