

the Haleakala Peripheral Hi Site; and

WHEREAS, access to Executive Order No. 1808 is via the access road encumbering Executive Order No. 1987 which is under the control and management of the Board of Regents of the University of Hawaii, and has been determined to not completely be located within the boundaries of Easements A, B, and C; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Aviation Administration and the University of Hawaii have agreed to seek correction of the legal description of Easements A, B, and C to match the actual location of the access road that was constructed and exists on the ground; and

WHEREAS, the legal description of Utility Easement D affecting Executive Order No. 1808 to the Federal Aviation Administration has been updated and corrected to match the actual location of the utility easement that was installed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BY THIS EXECUTIVE ORDER, I, the undersigned, Governor of the State of Hawaii, by virtue of the authority in me vested by Section 171-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, and every other authority me hereunto enabling, do hereby order that the public land and improvements hereinafter described be, and the same is, hereby set aside, as amended, for the following public purposes:


FOR HALEAKALA PERIPHERAL HI SITE, to be under the control and management of the United States of America, to be managed by the Federal Aviation Administration, being that parcel of land situate at Papaanui, Makawao, Maui, Hawaii, and identified as "(Revised-September 2012) Haleakala Peripheral Hi Site and Easements A-1, A-2 and D," consisting of:

Haleakala Peripheral Hi Site containing an area of 2.956 acres,

Access Road Easement A-1 containing an area of 0.430 acre,

Access Road Easement A-2 containing an area of 0.564 acre, and

Utility Easement D containing an area of 0.153 acre, more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and delineated on Exhibit "B," both of which are attached hereto and made parts hereof, said exhibits being respectively, a survey description



and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, both being designated C.S.F. No. 25,225 and dated September 17, 2012.

SUBJECT, HOWEVER, to the condition that upon cancellation of this executive order or in the event of non-use or abandonment of the premises or any portion thereof for a continuous period of one (1) year, or for any reason whatsoever, the United States of America, Federal Aviation Administration shall, within a reasonable time, restore the premises to a condition satisfactory and acceptable to the Department of Land and Natural Resources, State of Hawaii.

SUBJECT, FURTHER, to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this Executive Order.

This executive order does not authorize the recipient of the set aside to sell or exchange or otherwise relinquish the State of Hawaii's title to the subject public land.



HALEAKALA PERIPHERAL HI SITE

Beginning at the north corner of this parcel of land and on the southwest boundary of University of Hawaii Haleakala High Altitude Observatory Site, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "KOLEKOLE" being 217.45 feet North and 893.40 feet West, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 311° 22' 687.52 feet along University of Hawaii Haleakala High Altitude Observatory Site;
2. 65° 00' 218.31 feet along the remainder of the Government Land of Papaanui;
3. 131° 22' 600.00 feet along the remainder of the Government Land of Papaanui;
4. 221° 22' 200.00 feet along the remainder of the Government Land of Papaanui to the point of beginning and containing an AREA of 2.956 ACRES.



7. Thence along the remainder of University of Hawaii Haleakala High Altitude Observatory Site on a curve to the left with a radius of 50.00 feet, the chord azimuth and distance being:
121° 05' 55.48 feet;
8. 87° 23' 113.61 feet along the remainder of University of Hawaii Haleakala High Altitude Observatory Site;
9. 84° 57' 24.61 feet along the remainder of University of Hawaii Haleakala High Altitude Observatory Site;
10. 131° 22' 27.61 feet along Haleakala Peripheral Hi Site;
11. 264° 57' 44.06 feet along the remainder of University of Hawaii Haleakala High Altitude Observatory Site;
12. 267° 23' 114.03 feet along the remainder of University of Hawaii Haleakala High Altitude Observatory Site;
13. Thence along the remainder of University of Hawaii Haleakala High Altitude Observatory Site on a curve to the right with a radius of 70.00 feet, the chord azimuth and distance being:
301° 05' 77.68 feet;
14. 334° 47' 25.08 feet along the remainder of University of Hawaii Haleakala High Altitude Observatory Site;
15. Thence along the remainder of University of Hawaii Haleakala High Altitude Observatory Site on a curve to the left with a radius of 25.00 feet, the chord azimuth and distance being:
298° 51' 30" 29.34 feet;
16. 262° 56' 362.94 feet along the remainder of University of Hawaii Haleakala High Altitude Observatory Site;
17. Thence along the remainder of University of Hawaii Haleakala High Altitude Observatory Site on a curve to the left with a radius of 120.00 feet, the chord azimuth and distance being:
234° 41' 30" 113.57 feet;
18. 206° 27' 103.29 feet along the remainder of University of Hawaii Haleakala High Altitude Observatory Site;



- 5. Thence along a curve to the right with a radius of 257.38 feet, the length of curve being 58.52 feet and the chord azimuth and distance being: 2° 38' 49" 58.39 feet to the northeast boundary of University of Hawaii Haleakala High Altitude Observatory Site and containing an AREA OF 0.564 ACRE.

UTILITY EASEMENT D

Being a strip of land three (3.00) feet wide and extending one and one-half (1.50) feet on each side of the following described centerline:




