

Site," containing an area of 3.618 acres, more particularly described in Exhibit "A" and delineated on Exhibit "B," both of which are attached hereto and made parts hereof, said exhibits being respectively, a survey description and survey map prepared by the Survey Division, Department of Accounting and General Services, State of Hawaii, both being designated C.S.F. No. 25,348 and dated December 11, 2013.

SUBJECT, HOWEVER, to the condition that upon cancellation of this executive order or in the event of non-use or abandonment of the premises or any portion thereof for a continuous period of one (1) year, or for any reason whatsoever, the State of Hawaii, Department of Transportation shall, within a reasonable time, restore the premises to a condition satisfactory and acceptable to the Department of Land and Natural Resources, State of Hawaii.

SUBJECT, FURTHER, to disapproval by the Legislature by two-thirds vote of either the Senate or the House of Representatives or by majority vote of both, in any regular or special session next following the date of this Executive Order.


This executive order does not authorize the recipient of the set aside to sell or exchange or otherwise relinquish the State of Hawaii's title to the subject public land.

Keaahala, Kaneohe, Koolaupoko, Oahu, Hawaii

Being a portion of the Government (Crown) Land of Keaahala.

Beginning at the northeast corner of this parcel of land, at the southeast corner of Koolaupoko District Courthouse and Other Allied Purposes Site, Governor's Executive Order 4199 and on the west side of Pookela Street, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "HEEIA" being 13,443.17 feet South and 4343.61 feet East, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 4° 32' 815.25 feet along the west side of Pookela Street;
2. Thence along Parcel 1 of Hawaii State Hospital Site, Governor's Executive Order 3504 on a curve to the right with a radius of 30.00 feet, the chord azimuth and distance being:
49° 32' 42.43 feet;
3. 94° 32' 12.92 feet along Parcel 1 of Hawaii State Hospital Site, Governor's Executive Order 3504;
4. Thence along Parcel 1 of Hawaii State Hospital Site, Governor's Executive Order 3504 on a curve to the right with a radius of 220.00 feet, the chord azimuth and distance being:
112° 24' 134.99 feet;



5. 130° 16' 58.73 feet along Parcel 1 of Hawaii State Hospital Site, Governor's Executive Order 3504;
6. Thence along Parcel 1 of Hawaii State Hospital Site, Governor's Executive Order 3504 on a curve to the left with a radius of 382.00 feet, the chord azimuth and distance being:
197° 07' 21" 239.75 feet;
7. 178° 50' 538.21 feet along Parcel 1 of Hawaii State Hospital Site, Governor's Executive Order 3504;
8. 274° 32' 220.28 feet along Koolaupoko District Courthouse and Other Allied Purposes Site, Governor's Executive Order 4199 to the point of beginning and containing an AREA OF 3.618 ACRES.




TRUE NORTH
