In Recognition of Chevron's Fuel Your School Day

WHEREAS, Fuel Your School Day is an innovative collaboration between Chevron and DonorsChoose.org to help fund worthy classroom projects submitted by teachers who lack the necessary resources for their students and whose needs have ranged from pencils and microscope slides to live tarantulas for use in biology lessons, with more information available at www.FuelYourSchool.com; and

WHEREAS, Fuel Your School Day is designed to help support and improve critical education programming and materials, particularly in the STEM subjects — science, technology, engineering and math — to help prepare students for the growing number of technical jobs that will be required in the future, particularly in Hawai'i's dynamic and diversifying economy; and

WHEREAS, Fuel Your School Day creates an opportunity for Chevron and its customers to come together in support of education across the state, as Chevron will donate \$1, up to \$350,000, every time consumers purchase eight or more gallons of fuel at participating local Chevron stations in all Hawai'i counties throughout the month of October to help fund eligible classroom projects, raising public awareness and support for teachers and the innovative ways in which they are helping our students learn; and

WHEREAS, Fuel Your School Day expanded to Hawai'i in September 2013 and has since benefitted more than 406 schools and impacted more than 32,650 students, while in total Fuel Your School Day has helped fund 8,915 classroom projects at 1,924 schools across 14 Chevron markets in the United States since its inception in 2010;


