Presented

In Recognition of Glenn Cannon

WHEREAS, Glenn Cannon, a respected member of the Hawaii's acting community who mentored generations of young actors and inspired many; and served as President and Board member of the Hawaii'i Branch of the Screen Actors Guild for more than twenty years; and more recently served as the co-president of the newly merged SAG-AFTRA Hawaii'i local; and

WHEREAS, Glenn Cannon's career spanned more than 60 years in the entertainment industry ; from starring on Broadway to National touring companies of "The Threepenny Opera" and "West Side Story"; and

WHEREAS, Glenn Cannon's television career included roles on historic shows such as "Alfred Hitchcock Presents", "Combat" and the "Outer Limits" "Magnum P.I" and "Lost"; he also had recurring roles and performances on the original "Hawaii Five-0", and the today's reboot of "Hawaii Five-0" ;

WHEREAS, Glenn directed more than 100 shows, performed in countless stage productions and was awarded dozens of Po'okela Awards from the Hawaii State Theatre Council; and

WHEREAS, as a professor at both Stanford University & the University of Hawai'i, Glenn touched the lives of many young actors as a teacher, director and fellow actor; and

WHEREAS, Glenn's passion and integrity was unrivaled as a brilliant, funny, compassionate and noble man; having passed away on Saturday, April 20, 2013; he is survived by his wife, Samsil "Sam" Cannon, and son Caleb;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, NEIL ABERCROMBIE, Governor, and I, SHAN S. TSUTSUI, Lieutenant Governor of the State of Hawai'i, do hereby proclaim May 25, 2013, as
