Presented

In Recognition of Guy Toyama

WHEREAS, Guy Toyama, a visionary of great passion and humble spirit, vigorously advocated for renewable resources with innovative spirit and enthusiasm for the State of Hawai'i; and

WHEREAS, Guy Toyama defined a place for Hawai'i in the technology universe through professional collaborations with companies that represent the best in human innovation to light our way and fuel our 21st Century future; and

WHEREAS, Guy Toyama illuminated Honolulu's potential as the premiere alternative transportation city in the world when he identified specific ways to "decongest Honolulu" and bring about a fundamental shift in our relationship with transportation to make it a more pleasurable, shared experience; and

WHEREAS Guy Toyama is remembered through the Guy Toyama Memorial Fund, which supports ideals that Guy valued: sustainability, entrepreneurship, and volunteerism, and focuses on students and projects originating in Hawai'i that demonstrate the potential for highly regarded, worldwide impact; and
