Presented

In Recognition of the Producers, Cast and Crew of Hawai'i Five-0 and the Premiere of their 5th Successful Season

WHEREAS, Hawai'i Five-0, the original series, aired for 12 seasons on CBS from September 20, 1968 to April 4, 1980, placing it among the longest continuously-running police series in American television history, and breathing new life into this iconic series has been a continuing exciting venture for Hawai'i's film and television industry; and

WHEREAS, Hawai'i Five-0, the revived CBS crime drama series, was the most highly-anticipated new show of the 2010 fall season and officially premiered in the United States on September 20, 2010, a date 42 years to the day from the original series premiere on September 20, 1968; the show celebrated its second season premiere on September 19, 2011; its 3rd season premiere on September 24, 2012; its 4th season premiere September 27, 2013; and on March 13, 2014, CBS announced the 5th Season of Hawai'i Five-0, which is set to premiere on September 26, 2014 and will feature the show's 100th episode, which began filming on September 8, 2014; and

WHEREAS, due to the brilliant depiction of 1940s-era Hawai'i via both performance and authentic set design, Episode 410 "Ho'onani Makuakane" (Honor Thy Father), written by Peter M. Lenkov & Ken Solarz, was honored by the East West Players with the Visionary Award, the Japanese American Citizens League with the 2014 Salute to Champions of Diversity award, and the National Society of the Daughters of the American Revolution (NSDAR) Aloha Chapter with the Public Media Award; and

WHEREAS, Hawai'i Five-0 features a dynamically talented cast that has developed a global fan base for their portrayal of an elite federalized crime-fighting task force in Hawai'i, including:

- Alex O'Loughlin as Lieutenant Commander Steve McGarrett
- Scott Caan as Detective Sergeant Danny "Danno" Williams'
- Daniel Dae Kim as Detective Lieutenant Chin Ho Kelly
- Grace Park as Officer Kono Kalakaua
- Masi Oka as Dr. Max Bergman
- Chi McBride as Captain Lou Grover
- Jorge Garcia as Jerry Ortega; and

WHEREAS, Hawai'i Five-0 is filmed entirely on location in Hawai'i and has established headquarters at the State-owned and -operated Hawai'i Film Studio, home of the original Hawai'i Five-0 series;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, NEIL ABERCROMBIE, Governor, and **I, SHAN S. TSUTSUI**, Lieutenant Governor for the State of Hawai'i, do hereby proclaim September 13, 2014, as

in Hawai'i, and ask all citizens of the Aloha State to join us in commending the producers, cast and crew of CBS' **Hawai'i Five-0** for their excellent work as they embark on their 5th successful season, and extending best wishes to Hawai'i Five-0 for continued long-term success.
