Presented to

James "Jim" Sherwood Greenwell

WHEREAS, James "Jim" Sherwood Greenwell was born on March 13, 1945, in Honolulu, Hawai'i to James Mallaby Greenwell and Martha Lowrey Greenwell; attended Hanahauoli Elementary, Punahou School, Hawai'i Preparatory Academy and then Cornell University where he graduated with a degree in Agricultural Economics; and

WHEREAS, James "Jim" Sherwood Greenwell, while at Cornell, was a member of the Army Reserve Officer Training Corps and was named a distinguished military student, received his commission at graduation and spent two years in active duty with the 7th Infantry Division, which guarded the 38th parallel in South Korea; and

WHEREAS, James "Jim" Sherwood Greenwell returned to Hawai'i and started work in 1970 at Alexander & Baldwin on Maui where he worked in land use, and became a licensed real estate broker; and

WHEREAS, James "Jim" Sherwood Greenwell left A&B in 1980 for his family's ranch in Kona, Palani Ranch Co. and its parent real estate investment company Lanihau Properties; and

WHEREAS, James "Jim" Sherwood Greenwell has served his community faithfully, including serving on the Hawai'i Cattlemen's Council, the Hawai'i Cattle Producers Co-operative Association, as President of Kahului Business and Professional Association, trustee of Seabury Hall, Director of Maui Polo Club, Hawai'i Preparatory Academy Board of Governors, Kailua Village Improvement District and Lambda Alpha International; and

WHEREAS, James "Jim" Sherwood Greenwell was named Cattleman of the Year in 2004 by the Federal Land Bank; and

WHEREAS, James "Jim" Sherwood Greenwell is a valuable member of our community and has dedicated himself to the betterment of our State;

THEREFORE I, NEIL ABERCROMBIE, Governor, and I, SHAN S. TSUTSUI, Lieutenant Governor of the State of Hawai'i, do hereby proclaim January 19, 2013 as
