**WHEREAS**, The Magnum, P.I. television series was filmed in and around the North Shore on O'ahu, Hawai'i, and throughout the island for 158 episodes from 1980 to 1988; the show represents an iconic piece of TV history and still serves as a testament to the beauty of the Hawaiian Islands and particularly the scenic landscape, sandy beaches and vibrant people of O'ahu; and

**WHEREAS**, Magnum, P.I. featured the "The Chopper" as a central character in the TV show, along with Tom Selleck, aka Thomas Magnum; John Hillerman, aka Higgins; Larry Manetti, aka Rick; and Roger E. Mosley, aka T.C.; and

**WHEREAS**, Magnum, P.I. featured the North Shore as the backdrop for intrigue and an enviable island lifestyle and served to entice viewers from all over the world to visit Hawai'i and experience the beauty so richly displayed; and

**WHEREAS**, Magnum, P.I. featured the "Robbins Nest," located a few miles from Turtle Bay Resort, as Magnum's original residence, and today "The Chopper" returns home to the North Shore to make a permanent home;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, NEIL ABERCROMBIE, Governor, and I, SHAN S. TSUTSUI, Lieutenant Governor** for the State of Hawai'i, do hereby proclaim June 3, 2013, as

**"MAGNUM, P.I. CHOPPER DAY"**
