## Former State Representative John Justin Medeiros

**WHEREAS, John Justin Medeiros** was born in Hawai'i and graduated from Kaimuki High School in 1948 where he was a football all-star; and

**WHEREAS, John Justin Medeiros** served in the United States Army for seven years where he sustained a back injury during the Korean Conflict; and

**WHEREAS, John Justin Medeiros** served as a delegate to the State Constitutional Convention in 1968, chairman of the O'ahu Advisory Council from 1969 to 1970, member of the Hawai'i State Boxing Commission, and served the people of Kailua in the Hawai'i State House of Representatives from 1971 to 1988; and

**WHEREAS, John Justin Medeiros** devoted himself to serving his community; and an example of kindness, courage, and perseverance during his battle with Parkinson's disease; and

**WHEREAS, John Justin Medeiros** is survived by wife, Gloria T. Medeiros; son, Dwaine Medeiros; daughters, Pamela (Jim) Steir and Cindy (Jerry) Maser; sisters, Florence Puana and Rose Fryer; 11 grandchildren; 9 great-grandchildren; and many nieces and nephews;
