



Proclamation *Presented*

In Recognition of Marilyn B. Lee Day

WHEREAS, Marilyn B. Lee has served as a Representative in the Hawai'i State House of Representatives, representing District 38 Mililani from 1996 to 2012, where she served as the Majority Whip in 2012, Majority Floor Leader from 2000-2006, and where she was the dedicated force behind the Women's Legislative Caucus and their annual legislative package; and

WHEREAS, Marilyn B. Lee has been a registered nurse since 1962 and served as a nurse in the U.S. Navy from 1960 – 1966, until she met and married her late husband Sam Lee and took on the challenges of Foreign Service life; and

WHEREAS, Marilyn B. Lee returned to Hawai'i and worked at the Wahiawa General Hospital for 24 years, becoming Manager of the Medical Surgical Unit and in 1995, and creating the Wahiawa General Hospital Home Health Agency; and

WHEREAS, Marilyn B. Lee, ever conscious of community health and safety, was clearly at Sam's side as he led the fight to get developers of Mililani to rid the community's water system of pesticide contamination; and

WHEREAS, Marilyn B. Lee life-long interest in health issues also led her to work as a member of the Central Board of Directors for the American Cancer Society; later she become the founder and President of the Central O'ahu Caregivers Support Group, the Mililani Teen Support Organization, the Chair of the Legislative Action Committee of the Mililani Town Anti-Drug Committee, and the Chair of the Mililani Drug Free; she also served in various capacities on boards of non-profit organizations including, the Lions, Friends of the Mililani Library, and the Soroptimist of Hawai'i; and

WHEREAS, Marilyn B. Lee has remained dedicated to public service, currently serving on the Mililani Neighborhood Board and hosting a community issues talk show on 'Olelo, often featuring speakers on women's issues and health; and

THEREFORE I, NEIL ABERCROMBIE, Governor, and I, SHAN S. TSUTSUI, Lieutenant Governor of the State of Hawai'i, do hereby proclaim February 19, 2013, as
