**WHEREAS**, Randy K. Haynie, President of the National Association of State Lobbyists, leads the premier trade association for lobbyists in the United States; and

**WHEREAS**, Randy K. Haynie, like many of his peers, has an extensive history and outstanding record of achievement which, in his case, includes having served as Sergeant-at-Arms for the Louisiana State Senate; and

**WHEREAS**, Randy K. Haynie, as the President of Louisiana Governmental Studies, publishes the annual Louisiana Legislative Directory, the Grass-Roots Guide to Louisiana Legislature, and the Guide to the Louisiana Judiciary; and

**WHEREAS**, Randy K. Haynie picked up extensive knowledge of the oil industry while working summer months as a laborer while also a student at the University of Southern Louisiana; this experience later helped him acquire one of his first clients, The Louisiana Oilfield Contractors Association, which he still represents today; and

**WHEREAS**, Randy K. Haynie is just as involved in civic and professional organizations as he is in his businesses, an important value he developed as he achieved the rank of "Eagle" from the Boy Scouts of America; he currently serves on various museum boards throughout Louisiana, including the Ogden Museum of Southern Art in New Orleans, University of Louisiana Lafayette Museum, and Acadiana Center for the Arts in Lafayette; he has also served on the Bishop's Charity Ball Executive Committee for the Diocese of Lafayette since 1996, was selected the 13th Annual Bishop's Charity Ball King Louis XIII in 2000, is an active member of the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre, and was also accepted to the class of 2009 for the Order of Malta; and
