Presented

In Recognition of Pagoda Hotel & Restaurant's 50th Anniversary

WHEREAS, Pagoda Hotel & Restaurant recognizes that families and individuals from Hawai'i and the world over have enjoyed entertainment and gatherings at the Pagoda Hotel & Restaurant, from concerts and dinner shows to weddings, birthdays, reunions and conventions; and

WHEREAS, Pagoda Hotel & Restaurant highlights its pride in its local roots and Hawai'i's history of diverse cultures, continuing to provide exceptional value and service to the community; and

WHEREAS, Pagoda Hotel & Restaurant was originally built to cater to neighbor island visitors to O'ahu, but has also served those coming to the islands for medical treatment, having their homes tented, or participating in local sporting events, while providing a "home away from home" for Pacific Islanders and *kama'āina* now residing elsewhere; and

WHEREAS, Pagoda Hotel & Restaurant continues to strengthen its ties to island culture with cuisine featuring locally sourced ingredients and flavors in its ala carte service as well as its renowned dinner and brunch buffets; and

WHEREAS, Pagoda Hotel & Restaurant emphasizes its tranquility in the midst of busy metropolitan Honolulu as its signature, natural setting that has endured through five decades with harmonious features ranging from serene Eastern gardens to colorful koi swimming in its famous ponds; and

WHEREAS, Pagoda Hotel & Restaurant commemorates its 50th year of hospitality in 2014 by continuing to welcome generations of islanders and visitors through its doors;
