Maui County Council Member Michael "Mike" Paul Victorino

WHEREAS, Maui County Council Member Michael "Mike" Paul Victorino was born in Hilo on August 24, 1952, to parents William and Irene Cambra Victorino and has three siblings, Billy, Jocelyn and Natalie; and

WHEREAS, Maui County Council Member Michael "Mike" Paul Victorino spent many summers with his maternal grandparents, Manuel and Marian Mathias Cambra, at their family home in Haliimaile; Mike has fond memories of his grandparents, and Haliimaile holds a special place in his heart; and

WHEREAS, Maui County Council Member Michael "Mike" Paul Victorino graduated from Hilo High School and attended Hawai'i Community College, later securing a management position at the Hilo Zales Jewelry Store; a fateful transfer brought him to the island of Maui to open the new branch of Zales Jewelry Store at the Ka'ahumanu Shopping Center; and

WHEREAS, Maui County Council Member Michael "Mike" Paul Victorino then pursued another career opportunity as a manager of the Kahului McDonalds, where he met Joycelyn Nakahashi, who became Mrs. Joycelyn Victorino on Valentine's Day, February 14, 1976; their family grew and they were blessed with sons, Michael Jr. and Shane, and eventually their own respective families, including Michael Jr.'s wife, Kamele, and children, Kelcie and Aaron; and Shane's wife, Melissa, and children, Keenan, Kalia and Kingston; and

WHEREAS, Maui County Council Member Michael "Mike" Paul Victorino's professional career includes his employment as an Insurance Consultant with the Mutual Underwriters Insurance Agency (2001-present) and Manager at Bishop Insurance (1993-2001); and

WHEREAS, Maui County Council Member Michael "Mike" Paul Victorino's service in the community includes holding positions as the State Commission on Gender Equity (2000-present); Director for the Hawai'i Cup Soccer Tournament (1999-present); Director of the Maui County Fair Association (Chair 1997-2005); Director of the County of Maui Centennial Celebration (2005); Member of the Knights of Columbus (1990-2008), Grand Knight (2004-2007) and State Advocate (2007-present); and Board Member for the Maui Economic Concerns of the Community (2007-present); and
