**WHEREAS**, Daniel H. Case was born on February 25, 1925, in Lihue, Kaua'i to A. Hebard ("Hib") Case and Elisabeth McConnell Case; and

**WHEREAS**, Daniel H. Case graduated from Punahou School in 1942, obtained his bachelor's degree from Williams College in 1948 and earned his law degree from the University of Denver Sturm College of Law in 1952; and

**WHEREAS**, Daniel H. Case is a devoted husband, father and grandfather; has been married to his wife Carol for over 58 years with whom he raised 4 children --- Daniel, Carin, Stephen and Jeff -- and they have 12 grandchildren; and

**WHEREAS**, Daniel H. Case served with honor in the United States Navy as a Lieutenant; and

**WHEREAS**, Daniel H. Case is of counsel in the law firm of Case Lombardi & Pettit, which traces its roots back to 1888; joining the firm in 1952, then known as Vitousek, Tavares & Cassidy, and practicing in the areas of Estate Planning, Probate Wills and Trusts Law and Corporate Law; and has served the firm as an Associate, Partner, Named Partner, Managing Partner, Director; and

**WHEREAS**, Daniel H. Case is a past president of the Hawai'i State Bar Association, was a Member of the prestigious American College of Trust and Estate Counsel, and member of the Hawai'i State and American Bar Associations; in 1971, he served as a member on the Committee on Coordination of Rules and Statutes, (pursuant to HCR No. 24 for the Consideration of the Statutory Revision of the Hawai'i Revised Statutes); and

Case is active in community affairs and philanthropy having served as a Punahou School Trustee for three decades from 1970 to 2000, and continues to serve Punahou School as an Emeritus Trustee; created an Endowment Fund to establish an Entrepreneurship Program at Punahou School and was awarded the 2012 recipient of the prestigious Seymour Preston Award presented by the Council for the Advancement and Support of Education to honor his work in education; and
