Dr. Richard S. Lum

WHEREAS, Dr. Richard S. Lum served as Director of Bands for more than 25 years at the University of Hawai'i at Manōa since 1960 and was instrumental in building both the UH concert and marching bands which are regarded as among the best in the Nation; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Richard S. Lum was president of both the Hawai'i Music Education Association, a founder and past president of the O'ahu Band Directors Association, and State Chairman of the College Band Directors National Association and the National Band Association; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Richard S. Lum while UH Director of Bands also guest conducted various distinguished bands including the U.S. Armed Services Bi-Centennial Band, the University of Texas Band, the Arizona State Band, and the University of Illinois Band; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Richard S. Lum, in 1971, was invited to become a member of the American Bandmasters Association, and the following year, was inducted into the prestigious Phi Beta Mu as an honorary National Member; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Richard S. Lum was selected by the School Musician Magazine as one of the outstanding conductors in the United States and Canada for the school year 1974-75; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Richard S. Lum, in 1979, was selected by the All-American Magazine as Band Director of the Year, and in 1987, his alma mater, McKinley High School, installed him into the School's Hall of Honor; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Richard S. Lum continues to contribute his significant musical talents and lifelong experience to the State of Hawai'i working at the Hawai'i Pacific University and was recently awarded the Lifetime Achievement Award at the 2011 Hawai'i Music Awards;

NOW THEREFORE I, NEIL ABERCROMBIE, Governor of the State of Hawai'i, and I, Brian Schatz, Lieutenant Governor of the State of Hawai'i, do hereby proclaim December 3, 2012, as

"DR. RICHARD S. LUM DAY"
