# **The Salvation Army Hawaiian and Pacific Islands Division**

**WHEREAS**, The Salvation Army Hawaiian and Pacific Islands Division has honored The Salvation Army's more than 100-year tradition of providing spiritual counseling and basic human necessities such as food, clothing and shelter to the underprivileged and disenfranchised; and

**WHEREAS**, The Salvation Army Hawaiian and Pacific Islands Division has served as a "beacon of hope" to thousands of immigrants who immigrated to Hawai'i to work in plantations in the 1890s; since its beginning the organization has provided service to more than 134,000 individuals in Hawai'i and throughout the Pacific Islands including Guam, Republic of the Marshall Islands and The Federated States of Micronesia since the late 1890s; and

**WHEREAS**, The Salvation Army Hawaiian and Pacific Islands Division programs include:

- Substance Abuse Services (Addiction Treatment, Adult Rehabilitation Center, and Family Treatment)
- Emergency Disaster Services
- Homeless Services (Hale Palekana, Care-A-Van, William Booth Safe Haven, and Kokua Soup Kitchen)
- Youth and Family Services (Family Intervention Services, Camp Homelani and Preschool)
- Seniors (Adult Day Health Services and Silvercrest Senior Housing)

**WHEREAS**, The Salvation Army Hawaiian and Pacific Islands Division, through its charitable activities including Women's Auxiliary Fashion Revue, Community Service Sponsors partnerships, Fashion Revue Clothing Drive, and Red Kettle Drive, has lifted the spirits of needy families and families of those incarcerated during the holiday season;
