In Recognition of the Asia-Pacific Information Management Conference

WHEREAS, the Asia-Pacific Information Management Conference will be held at the Ala Moana hotel from July 11, 2012 through July 12, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Asia-Pacific Information Management Conference will bring together representatives from China, Japan, Korea, Philippines, Thailand, Australia, New Zealand, the United Kingdom, California, Arizona, Nevada, Utah, Oregon, Washington, and Hawai'i under the auspices of the Association of Records Managers and Administrators (ARMA) International, the ARMA Hawai'i Chapter, and Pacific Region members, to promote professionalism, education, research and networking opportunities to general organizational success; and
