Presented

In Recognition of Pedestrian Safety Month

WHEREAS, Hawai'i's beautiful weather allows us to walk almost anywhere at any time; and walking is a healthy, safe and enjoyable way to get to our destinations; and

WHEREAS, Hawai'i State Department of Transportation; Hawai'i County Police Department; Honolulu Police Department; Kaua'i Police Department; Maui Police Department; Federal Highway Administration; McDonald's Restaurants of Hawai'i; Kama'aina Kids; Longs Drugs; Tesoro Hawai'i; AAA Hawai'i; the City & County of Honolulu's Department of Transportation Services; and The Limtiaco Company for Walk Wise Hawai'i are dedicated to promoting and encourage pedestrian safety throughout our State; and
