Presented to

Yoshihiko Kamo **Consul General of Japan in Honolulu**

WHEREAS, Consul General Yoshihiko Kamo was born in 1952 in Shizuoka Prefecture, Japan; and

WHEREAS, Consul General Yoshihiko Kamo graduated from Tokyo University, Faculty of Engineering, in 1976 and joined the Ministry of Foreign Affairs; and

WHEREAS, Consul General Yoshihiko Kamo served in Tokyo as Director of the Southwest Asia Division's Ministry of Foreign Affairs; Director General of the International Affairs Department; and Secretariat of the House of Representatives; and

WHEREAS, Consul General Yoshihiko Kamo's many years of dedicated service to the people of Japan has included his overseas assignments at the Embassies of Japan in Bangladesh, Thailand, Canada, Myanmar and Finland; and Consul General Kamo has also served at the Consulate of Japan in Houston, Texas; and

WHEREAS, Consul General Yoshihiko Kamo arrived in Honolulu in August 2009 and has served as the official representative of the Government of Japan in the State of Hawai'i and American Samoa;

NOW, THEREFORE I, NEIL ABERCROMBIE, Governor, and I, BRIAN SCHATZ, Lieutenant Governor of the State of Hawaii, do hereby proclaim August 23, 2012, as
