Presented to

Pastor Wayne Cordeiro

WHEREAS, Pastor Wayne Cordeiro is the founding Pastor of New Hope Christian Fellowship in Honolulu with more than 14,500 in weekend attendance and more than 3,000 attending services each week via the Internet;

WHEREAS, Pastor Wayne Cordeiro has led New Hope Christian Fellowship to unprecedented success; earning New Hope Christian Fellowship a listing as one of the top ten most innovative churches in America with Outreach Magazine, which also listed the Fellowship as one of the "top five churches to learn from"; and

WHEREAS, Pastor Wayne Cordeiro is credited with more than 108 churches established in the Pacific Rim countries of the Philippines, Japan, Australia and Myanmar; nationally, he is also credited with establishing churches in Hawai'i, California, Montana, Washington and Nevada; and

WHEREAS, Pastor Wayne Cordeiro also serves as Chancellor over his alma mater, Eugene Bible College, now known as New Hope Christian College (NHCC), which is part of a consortium of New Hope Christian Colleges with locations in Hawai'i, Oregon, Myanmar and Tokyo; and

WHEREAS, Pastor Wayne Cordeiro has authored eleven books, including "Doing Church as a Team"; "Dream Releasers"; "Seven Rules of Success"; "Attitudes That Attract Success"; "Divine Mentor"; "Leading on Empty"; and "The Irresistible Church"; he is also the author of the Life Journal, which is being utilized by thousands of churches worldwide in bringing people back to the Word of God; and
